



Kniterary Complimentary Hat Pattern



Before You Begin

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: one size. 21 inch circumference

Yarn: 170 metres (100 gm) worsted weight
suggest yarn: Cascade 220, Manos del Uruguay Maxima

Needles:

4.5 mm circular 16 inches long
and 4.5 double pointed needles for no seam
or
4.5 mm straight needles for seamed hat

Other items: Darning Needle

Gauge:

18stitches slightly stretched in 2x2 rib is 4 inches

Hints and Tips: Change to dpns when circular needle is too short to work stitches comfortably

Stitch Details

PM: Place marker

SM: Slip marker

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2Tog: Knit two stitches together to form one stitch

* instruction * : repeat instructions between *'s as many times as indicated

No Seam (work in rounds)

Cast On: 96 Stitches

Place marker at beginning and Join in Round

Row 1: * P2, K2 * 24 times

Repeat row 1 for 6 inches (no brim) or 8 inches (brim)

Decrease rows:

Row 1: * P2, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (88 sts)

Row 2 and even rows to row 18: Purl the purl stitches and knit the knit stitches

Row 3: * P2, K2, P2, K2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (80 sts)

Row 5: * P2, K2, P2, K1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (72 sts)

Row 7: * P2, K2, P2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (64 sts)

Row 9: * P2, K2, P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (56 sts)

Row 11: * P2, K2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (48 sts)

Row 13: * P2, K1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (40 sts)

Row 15: * P2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (32 sts)

Row 17: * P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (24 sts)

Row 19: * K2Tog, K1 * 8 times (16 sts)

Row 20: * K2Tog * 8 times (8 sts)

Finishing:

Break yarn and thread through stitches. Fasten off Firmly
Dampen and block

Seam (work flat)

Cast On: 98 Stitches

Row 1: K1, *P2, K2 * 24 times, K1

Row 2: P1, * P2, K2 * 24 times, P1

Repeat row 1-2 for 6 inches (no brim) or 8 inches (brim)

Decrease rows:

Row 1: K1, * P2, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (90 sts)

Row 2 and even rows to row 18: Purl the purl stitches and knit the knit stitches

Row 3: K1, * P2, K2, P2, K2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (82 sts)

Row 5: K1, * P2, K2, P2, K1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (74 sts)

Row 7: K1, * P2, K2, P2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (66 sts)

Row 9: K1, * P2, K2, P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (58 sts)

Row 11: K1, * P2, K2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (50 sts)

Row 13: K1, * P2, K1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (42 sts)

Row 15: K1, * P2, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (34 sts)

Row 17: K1, * P1, K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (26 sts)

Row 19: K1, * K2Tog, K1 * 8 times, K1 (18 sts)

Row 20: K1, * K2Tog * 8 times, K1 (10 sts)

Finishing:

Break yarn and thread through stitches. Fasten off Firmly
Sew seam. Ensure brim seam is made on outside so when brim is turned up the seam does not show
Dampen and block



Kniterary Complimentary Scarf Pattern

Before You Begin

Skill Level: Beginner

Size: one size

Length: repeat until desired length or yarn is used

Yarn:

126 metres (100 gm) bulky weight ; Colour A

126 metres (100 gm) bulky weight ; Colour B

Suggested yarn: Manos del Uruguay, Wool Clasica

Needles: 7 mm straight

Other items: Darning Needle

Gauge: not important

Hints and Tips: Carry the yarn not in use up the side

Stitch Details

K: Knit

P: Purl

PM: Place marker

SM: Slip marker

Instruction

Cast On: 30 Stitches in Multi-colour Yarn

Start of scarf

Use Colour A

Row 1: (K1, P1) repeat to last stitch, K1

Row 2: same as row 1

Throughout: do not break yarn, carry yarn up the side

Use Colour B

Row 3: repeat row 1

Row 4: repeat row 1

Use Colour A

Row 5: repeat row 1

Row 6: repeat row 1

Main Part of scarf:

Use Colour B

Row 7: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, PM, K20, PM, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1

Row 8: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, SM, P20, SM, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1

Use Colour A

Row 9: Repeat row 7

Row 10: Repeat row 8

Repeat main part of scarf (rows 7-10) until desired length or enough yarn is left to finish the next 8 rows

Use Colour B

Row 11: Repeat row 7

Row 12: Repeat row 8

End of scarf:

Use Colour A

Row 13: Repeat row 7

Row 14: Repeat row 8

Use Colour B

Row 15: repeat row 1

Row 16: repeat row 1

Use Colour A

Row 17: repeat row 1

Row 18: bind off in pattern

Finishing:

Work ends in

Dampen and block
