

# 🌿 36 Stitch Cowl 🌿

## Before You Start

Skill Level: Beginner

Size: One Size

Finished Measurements: 28 in around x 5 in tall

Yarn: Berroco Link

30 metres (200 gm) Massively super bulky weight

Needles: 12.75mm or 15mm circular (the bigger the better)

Gauge: ☺ I didn't measure, but it should not be too stiff. If it is stiff, knit a little looser.

## Stitch Details

*K*: Knit

*P*: Purl

*YO*: Yarn over the needle

*YO*: Yarn over the needle

( *instruction* ): repeat the instructions within the ellipses as instructed

## Instructions

Using long tail cast on using a tail 5.5 feet long, cast on 36 stitches. Place marker.

Join in round, being careful not to twist.

Row 1: Purl around, slip marker

Row 2: Knit around, slip marker

Row 3: (K1, YO, K1) repeat around, slip marker : 54 stitches

Row 4: (K1, drop the YO, K1 ) repeat around, slip marker : 36 stitches

Row 5: Repeat row 3

Row 6: Repeat row 4

Row 7: Repeat row 3

Row 8: Repeat row 4

Row 9: Repeat row 3

Cast off loosely in purl as follows: P1, (YO, P1, pass the YO and first P over the P just made, P1, pass the P over the P just made) repeat around.

Finishing: Bind off last stitch and work the end in.

If the cast off edge may be a bit larger than the cast on edge, wear the cowl with that edge at your shoulders.

If you make this cowl with 30 stitches it can be used as a head band/ear warmer!
